ID Badges

A reminder that all students must have their ID badges on them at all time. A failure to do so will result but is not limited to a lunch detention and possibly Saturday School as well as the cost of replacement of the ID badge. It is an essential part of our school and district security plan.

Forgotten Items in Cars

Students are responsible for entering the building prepared for school. They are provided a locker to store those items. Stevenson HS is a closed campus. We will not be taking students out to cars to get forgotten items unless it is a health emergency that requires immediate attention. Students have to be responsible for their materials and prepared for school when they enter school.

Lunches and Deliveries

We do not allow anyone other than an approved parent/contact to deliver lunch. External deliveries (e.g. Jimmy Johns, Jets Pizza, Grub Hub, etc.) will be denied and sent away. Students have access to lunches through food services or can pack a lunch. Parents who drop off lunch during the day may do so and leave them for students at our drop-off table in the main office. Our office staff will not contact students to pick these items up, so you will have to work out a process to notify your child.

Wait List for Parking

Stevenson High School has approximately 400 parking spots for students. We have almost 1900 students, not every student can receive a spot. We have honored all senior requests that were submitted on time. Now, all Seniors and Juniors turning in applications for parking will be put on a wait list for a parking permit according to their 18-29 attendance record from best to worst (excused absences do not count against the student). Ties in attendance will be broken based on when the application was submitted.

Students must have a valid 2019-20 Stevenson parking permit to park at Stevenson. Students with a valid parking permit cannot park in a reserved or visitor spot and must follow all parking rules. Students in violation of parking are subject to fines, suspension and towing.

We will begin in the Auditorium at 7:00 p.m. Following the general session, parents will break out to walk their students schedule and visit teacher classrooms to hear an overview of the course. PSAT/NMSQT

On October 19th, 2019, Stevenson is offering the PSAT/NMSQT to all juniors who wish to participate. Although any junior may take this test, we are encouraging all juniors who have (1) selected a rigorous high school curriculum that would strongly prepare them for the SAT and/or (2) any junior who met the benchmark score of 430 or higher on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section and the benchmark score of 480 or higher on the Math section of the PSAT 10.

The PSAT has many benefits **for juniors**, such as updating their personalized Official SAT practice experience in Khan Academy. The College Board states, "New data Links 20 hours of personalized Official SAT practice on Khan Academy to 115-point average score gains." Also, taking the PSAT provides an opportunity to compete for scholarships. Eligible juniors will automatically be entered into scholarship and recognition competitions by taking the test. These competitions include the prestigious National Merit Scholarship Program. Scholarships not only help you pay for college, but they can also help you stand apart from other students in the college admissions process.

Any junior interested in taking this test may sign up for the test on Stevenson PaySchools site. The cost for the test is \$24 and can be paid with a check or using Stevenson PaySchools site. The PaySchools link is under the "site index" tab of our website.

Testing will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. Be sure to bring your identification. to the testing session. To practice for the PSAT, refer to the following link to download a practice assessment: <http://tinyurl.com/gaa5dd4>.
