Stevenson Cyber Security Team Finishes in the top 25% of the nation and 5th in the State

Stevenson High School ran a new Cyber Security class this year. Students put their learning from this fledgling program to the test and performed admirably! Congratulations students and their teacher Mrs. Gendelman!

On April 24 and 25, 2019, a team of six Stevenson students from our CTE Cybersecurity program participated in a virtual Cyber Challenge sponsored by the National Governors Association (NGA) and the National Integrated Cyber Education Research Center (NICERC). The NGA Capture the Flag Cyber Challenge Event was hosted on the Virginia Cyber Range. Students were required to complete a series of virtual Cybersecurity challenges within the 24-hour competition period. Competition challenges included Reconnaissance, Web Exploitation, Cryptography, Networking and Reverse Engineering. There were 300+ high school teams around the country participating in the

challenge and our Stevenson team placed 68th. Among other teams in Michigan we were in 5th place! Congrats to these wonderful students for accepting a new challenge during this inaugural year of our UCS Cybersecurity course.
