Advanced Placement Registration Information

College Board has changed the way students registered for their AP Exams. Registration now begins in the fall! Students will add all their AP classes to their College Board account using join codes given by AP teachers. How to register and pay for AP Exams will be shared over the next two weeks. The registration deadline will be November 8, 2019. AP Exams will cost \$98 with AP Capstone tests (Seminar & Research) costing \$148. All amounts are per test.

This program will help you complete the milestones to make your way to higher education while also providing campus visits, SAT preparation, FAFSA workshops, and college application assistance. After completing three years in the program, each student receives a \$4,000 scholarship to help break down the financial barrier. Junior News and Information

On October 19th, 2019, Stevenson is offering the PSAT/NMSQT to all juniors who wish to participate. Although any junior may take this test, we are encouraging all juniors who have (1) selected a rigorous high school curriculum that would strongly prepare them for the SAT and/or (2) any junior who met the benchmark score of 430 or higher on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section and the benchmark score of 480 or higher on the Math section of the PSAT 10.

The PSAT has many benefits **for juniors**, such as updating their personalized Official SAT practice experience in Khan Academy. The College Board states, “New data Links 20 hours of personalized Official SAT practice on Khan Academy to 115-point average score gains.” Also, taking the PSAT provides an opportunity to compete for scholarships. Eligible juniors will automatically be entered into scholarship and recognition competitions by taking the test. These competitions include the prestigious National Merit Scholarship Program. Scholarships not only help you pay for college, but they can also help you stand apart from other students in the college admissions process.

Any junior interested in taking this test may sign up for the test on Stevenson PaySchools site. The cost for the test is \$24 and can be paid with a check or using Stevenson PaySchools site. The PaySchools link is under the “site index” tab of our website.

Testing will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. Be sure to bring your identification. to the testing session. To practice for the PSAT, refer to the following link to download a practice assessment: <http://tinyurl.com/qaa5dd4>.. **Make time to take the practice test, as it is the best way to get ready for the PSAT/NMSQT.**
