State Finalists Emma Bowen(All-County, All-MAC, All-Region), Lucy Potts (All-MAC, All-Region), Amanda Palmer (All-County, All-MAC), Jade Burnett (All-County, All-MAC), Heather Hare, Delaney Anglin and Greenlee Anglin represented the Titans well in the championship race.

Other highlights for the Stevenson Girls:

- Champions of the Autumn Classic at Stony Creek.
- 2nd place finish in M.A.C. Red Dual Meets with a 6-1 record.
- 3rd place at Macomb County Championship.

The Titans also earned five spots on the Macomb County All-Academic team and nine on the M.A.C. All-Academic team.

The team members elected Olivia Dickerson the Most Improved Runner, Amanda Palmer Rookie of the Year, Emma Bowen Most Outstanding Performer and Lucy Potts earned the Leadership Award.

Volleyball

It was another good year for the Volleyball Program. We moved up to the MAC Red division for the first time in recent memory and tested our mettle in the top division of one of the toughest conferences in the state. Despite some adversity within our ranks and taking a few games on the chin in the process, the girls responded with heart and determination, finishing in 4th place in the league at 4-6 (25-17-3 overall). The JV and Freshman teams also showed a lot of growth throughout the year, proving that the future is promising as well for Titan Volleyball.

In the MHSAA state playoffs, the team earned victories over Ford II and Dakota in the District round, winning our 5th consecutive District Championship in the process. This earned a spot in the Regional against a very tough opponent in L'Anse Creuse North (40-6), ultimately falling in four sets. 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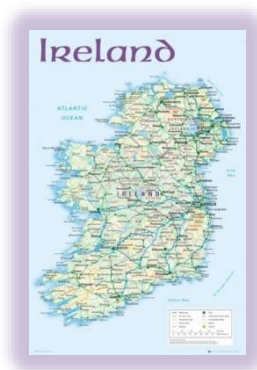
