Dear Titan Families,

It seems hard to believe but the Stevenson Counseling staff will be meeting soon with students to begin the scheduling process for the 2020-2021 school year. In the not too distant future, you can expect your child to be bringing home with them some paperwork for selecting their courses for next year. I encourage you look over the scheduling information that is brought home and to have a conversation. Review your child's college and career goals and create a pathway. Parental involvement is very important in the process of selecting courses for next year.

There is much research that shows that the more rigorous a workload a student takes in high school, the more prepared that student will be for college. That being said, it is imperative that students make decisions about course loads that take into account all factors including extracurricular activities, athletics and work schedules. Students need to feel comfortable that their selected course load is realistic and manageable. I encourage you to explore the advanced courses offered here at Stevenson. With Advanced Placement (AP) courses ranging from Art to Computer Science to Calculus, every student should explore our AP course options to see what interests them and consider selecting from them for next year.

Stevenson students qualify to earn college credit every year by participating in an AP course experience and scoring well on the corresponding AP test in May. There are many benefits to selecting an AP course. Feel free to have a conversation with your Stevenson counselor to obtain the information you need to make the best decision possible. On that note, I would like to congratulate Riley Klumb and Kirthika Krishnan for their success on becoming a National Merit Scholar Finalist!

Scheduling for the 2020-21 school year will begin in March and continue through April. After students receive their scheduling materials from their counselor, they will be required to enter their schedule requests in Power School. In order to complete this process every student will be required to set up a Unified Classroom account, if they haven't already. The directions for setting up an account are printed below. Please see Mrs. Brown in the Counseling Office if you are having trouble setting up an account.

TO CREATE A UNIFIED CLASSROOM ACCOUNT

User ID – student school email address (last name, first initial@stu.uticak12.org)

Password – your “Its” password with a **zero** at the end

To create an account, do the following:

- Go to <https://ps.ucs.misd.net/public>
- Scroll down to create an account
- Click on student sign in
- You then sign in with your old information (capital letters and numbers) See Mrs. Brown if you don't know your old information
- It will prompt you to create the unified account
- Type in ID (SCHOOL email)
- Type in password (Its password with a zero on the end)

If you have tried to create this and it prompts that you have an account with a different email you need to see Mrs. Brown in the Counseling Office so she can contact technology to have them reset it.

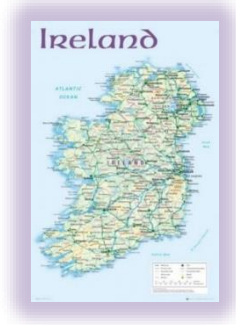

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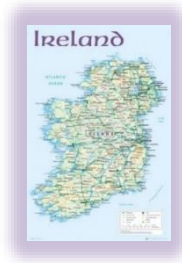
